The FM Ferry Experiment is a project conceived and programmed by the artist duo neuro Transmitter (Angel Nevarez + Valerie Tevere) in cooperation with the New York City Department of Transportation and WSIA 88.9-FM. For eight-days this project will transform the ferry into a floating radio station, continuously broadcasting out to the region as it travels between Staten Island and Lower Manhattan. Live programs consisting of lectures, interviews, and sound performances will take place on the hurricane deck of the Molinari class ferries and will be broadcast along with music, sound, and ambience via 88.9-FM and fmferryexperiment.net
